WARM-UP RING WILL BE PROVIDED AT THE TRIALS. THIS RING WILL BE MONITORED.

All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring. Handlers are responsible for cleaning up after their own dogs.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

Proof of current rabies vaccination must be in the possession of exhibitors or handlers for all dogs at these trials.

- ** The safety of the dogs is our primary concern.** By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all exercises safely.
- ** Dogs are not required to be at the show until the scheduled time of judging.** All dogs not needed for further judging will be excused.

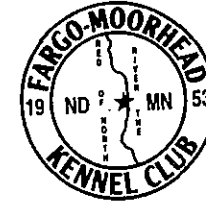
