

Fargo Moorhead Kennel Club Crating Policy

Only Fargo Moorhead Kennel Club members who are registered for a current class, Board of Director Members, and instructors, are allowed crating space.

- There is to be no crating in or next to the rings, except for temporary use when training. The crate(s) must be removed from ringside immediately following class. Only the Public crates are allowed to stay overnight at ring side.
- Members and non-members without crates may use the public crates as long as they wipe them down with an antibacterial cleaner after use. They also may bring in crates for classes, and then remove the crates after class for that day.
- Please make sure dogs are crate trained. We will help with puppies that are new to crate training.
- Members and instructors will be allowed more than one crate if they routinely train more than one dog in the same day/time period and they will/cannot share the same crate.
- All crates must have the members name and phone number attached.
- Crate space will be reviewed to accommodate new members.
- No dogs are to remain overnight in the FM Kennel Club Building.
- If you have a reactive dog or a dog that needs a little more personal space, please add a yellow ribbon to your crate. This will help create awareness and provide a clear indicator that the dog needs others to leave some distance when passing the crate.
- Any issues with crating should be addressed to the Board of Directors.

We understand that the following is not always possible, but if so:

- We ask that those with smaller dogs to use the tops of the tables.
- Please do not place the large 42" crates under tables. They hinder the ability for anyone to use the space above.
