Dog Eligibility

These Fetch tests are open to open to all dogs at least 6 months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC Canine Partners listing number or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate. Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete.

Condition of the Dog: Dogs with physical challenges (including amputees) are eligible to participate provided that, in the opinion of the judge, they display no signs of physical discomfort and can safely complete the Fetch test. Dogs with bandages, sutures, or visible wounds are not eligible. Deaf dogs are allowed to enter so long as the handler is in control of the dog at all times, the dog can complete the requirements of the test, and the dog does not appear to be under undue stress in the opinion of the judge.

Females in-season: May not participate Refunds will be given to in-season females. We must be notified in writing (preferably email) at least 30 minutes prior to the first class of the first test.

Entries

Entry Method: First received. No entries will be accepted by phone, email, or fax. Express mail entries must include the signature waiver allowing them to be left at the secretary's address. Inquiries may be directed to Jack Loken at harmonydogsports@gmail.com. No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. **Illegible entries** will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. Returned checks to not constitute a valid entry and the test secretary will add a \$50 collection fee to the amount of the returned check. Entries may be hand delivered at other HarmonyDogSports events.

Online Entries Preferred: Online entries will be accepted upon opening day and time of test opening until the event is full. Visit www.harmonydogsports.com/events. Online entries will be turned off upon reaching daily limits.

By Mail: Complete an official AKC entry form for each dog. ONE ENTRY FORM PER DOG. Multiple tests may be selected for the same dog on one entry form. Dogs may enter only once per competition test. Multiple entry forms for multiple dogs (maximum 5 entry forms) may be mailed together and paid with one check. Mail completed form(s) with fees payable to: **HarmonyDogSports** - 6860 S Adams Way, Centennial, CO 80122.

Day of Test Entries: Day of test entries may be available based on space and/or time available. Entry fee per run is \$35. Register online, or complete paper entry at the Secretary table. Cash and Credit accepted. There will be a \$1.50 credit card, PayPal and Venmo fee assessed.

Withdrawing Entries/Refunds: No entry fees shall be refunded if a dog is absent. Also, no entries will be refunded if a dog is disqualified, excused, or banned from competition by the test committee. Any entries pulled prior to pre-entry closing date must be made via email or mail. No entries may be withdrawn with a refund post-closing date. Exception, females in season will be refunded their entry.

There will be a secretary table for check-ins and information.

Check In for all tests will start at 8:30am on the day of the tests, unless the committee and secretary are set up and ready to start taking dogs earlier. **You must be checked in and ready to run by 2:30pm each day.**

Order of Judging: Dogs may run back to back. There is not a running order, however, Retriever and Advanced dogs will be given priority. We will also group dogs together by level if there are several dogs that arrive to run at the same time. **WE WILL BE ABLE TO Accommodate Conflicts!**

Judging: Judges are not required to wait for dogs. **The owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at the search area when it is to be judged.** The host has no responsibility to provide service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required. We will move you to the end of the class if you miss your time in the ring as long as the class for that test is still running. Once the next test starts, you will not be able to compete in the test that has closed. **If you anticipate a conflict, please let the secretary and board runner know.**

Crating: Dogs must be crated out of view of the Fetch test area, or far enough away as to not cause a distraction to the dog being tested.

Awards

Qualifying Runs: All dogs who receive a qualifying score will receive a flat green ribbon.

New Title Ribbons will be offered for all dogs earning a fetch title on the weekend, customized tabs will also be provided. **Rosettes will NOT be mailed.**

Notice to All Exhibitors

Females in season will be refunded the full entry fee. Notification in writing must be given to the event secretary no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class of the day of the test.

Clean-up After Your Dog: Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without the benefit of a refund if the event committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available.

Weather: This is a rain, snow, or shine event. In the case of extreme weather, the host and its committee may delay or cancel the event. If the host makes the determination to cancel the event, entry fees may or may not be refunded. Please ensure you and your dog's comfort by bringing portable shade, shelter, water, etc.. .

Safety: The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all searches safely.

Behavior: It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

Collars, Leashes, and Harnesses: Dogs must wear a collar. Dogs may wear slip collars, buckle collars, and Martingales in the AKC Fetch test. They may not wear prong collars, e-collars, head collars, muzzles, or body harnesses. Leashes should be 4 ft. to 6 ft. long and should be made of fabric, leather, or biothane.

Media: All rights to televise, videotape, advertise, photograph, promote or otherwise exploit this event are vested in the host, or in persons to whom assignments of such rights have been made in writing by the host. All persons and animals attending these shows grant the host the right to use their likeness and voice in any matter without further consent.

Conduct: Persons exhibiting conduct detrimental to AKC /the Club/any dogs(s) and/or other person(s) will be asked to leave the test(s).

Veterinarian Advice: Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites or infectious diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.
